Responsibilities:

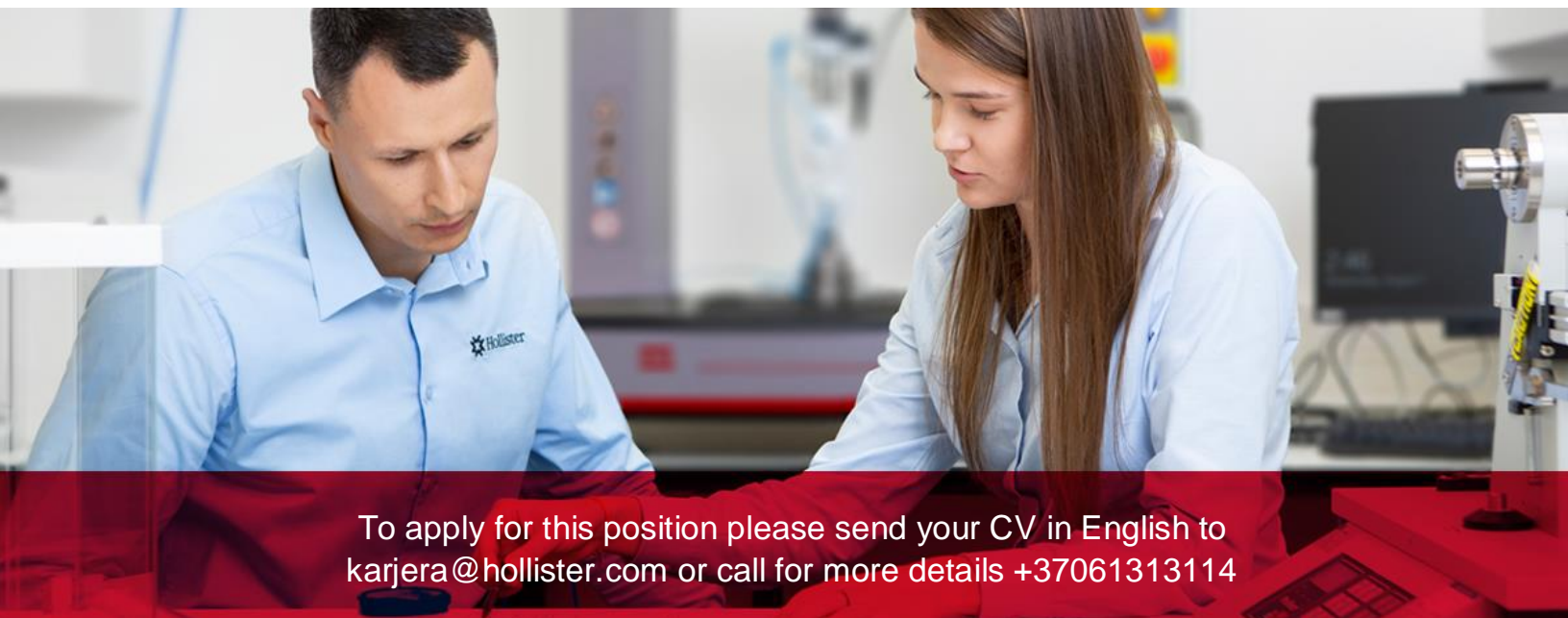
- Coordinate and collaborate with technical development, business application and database architecture functions to ensure availability of corporate network infrastructure
