THE HUMAN SIDE OF TECHNOLOGY

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
With this slogan, KTU introduces itself to the world. This short message conveys a lot.

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



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
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ORGANISATION OF STUDIES

Study programme is made of study modules that are

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MODULE taught for one semester. A study module may include various combinations of lectures, laboratory work, practice, seminars, the student's independent work, scientific research, design work or other type of work. Study modules may be mandatory, alternative (selected from a list), general and optional (from the list of modules University offers). Studies of each module are completed by an evaluation of the students-knowledge and skills an examination or a different form of final assessment. Find your timetable, assessment evaluation and other relevant information about studies in the Academic Information System (AIS). STUDY The scope of studies is measured in study credits that CREDIT describe a student's workload. The full-time study workload for one year is 60 credits - 1600 work hours. In the University, the cumulative assessment method **SYSTEM** is used: study results are measured by intermediate assessments, and the final grade is the sum of the results of intermediate assessments and the final assessment. A student is allowed to participate in the final assessment only if all intermediate assessments were submitted.

ATTENDANCE

It is mandatory to attend classes at KTU: 100% in laboratory works, \geq 80% in practical classes, \geq 80% in lectures. The specific attendance requirements are set by each teacher and are presented in the first class of the module. Disciplinary penalties are applied to students who do not attend classes under the determined procedure.

TUITION FEES

In the University, tuition fees are applied for:

- studying in non-state-funded positions;
- retaking separate study modules;
- studying additional modules that are not included in your study programme;
- retaking the intermediate or final module assessment for a second time;
- retaking a module in the following semester due to have not passed the final module assessment.

ACADEMIC HELP

Complex academic support is provided to our students:

- "GUIDed" mentorship programme;
- individual professors' consultations;
- bridging courses of the core subjects of studies (English, Math, Physics, Chemistry, IT).

ACADEMIC HONESTY

The base of the culture of your University is academic values and principles of ethics. Academic honesty is one of the most important academic University values. Remember that no form of cheating in attempt to get a grade for your individual semester tasks and no form of cheating in final assessments are tolerated. Dishonest conduct has consequences – you receive an academic penalty, consequently losing the right to retake your assessments. Having breached the Code of Academic Ethics the student could be expelled from the University.

All study regulations and documents can be found in KTU students' intranet "Office 365". Students must get acquainted with recent and relevant orders and documents and follow their changes.

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SERVICES

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IT USER REGISTRATION

KTU has implemented a unified connection to the University's information systems and information technology (IT) services. After signing the study agreement by e-mail you will receive an information letter, which invites you to register an IT user login.

For the University students e-mail services during entire study period are provided in the Microsoft "Office 365" environment in the namespace ktu.edu. All study related information and faculty letters are sent to the official academic e-mail (@ktu.edu). In order to receive answers to all questions and request it is essential to use only this e-mail provided by KTU.



- Join the University Sports Club or the Sports and Wellness Centre teams and stay in good physical shape free of charge.



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

It offers the opportunity to study and acquire hands-on experience, creates an environment of openness and tolerance and encourages the dialogue of cultures and a global way of thinking. Erasmus scholarships - up to 700 EUR/ month! "ERASMUS+" KTU has almost 400 partners offering quality **STUDIES** programmes and new student experiences. These studies are fully transferable between universities and the results are included in your diploma. The call for applications is announced in September and March. You can do internships in the companies, science **INTERNSHIPS** research centres and other organisations that are in the countries participating in the "ERASMUS+" programme. You can do summer internships in between semesters and (or) an internship after graduation. During your mandatory summer internship, you will acquire professional knowledge, get acquainted with the job market requirements and establish both business and new personal relations. BILATERAL You can travel abroad for 1-2 semester exchange studies EXCHANGE and for the summer / winter programmes, as KTU has **OUTSIDE OF** a number of bilateral cooperation and student exchange **EUROPE!** agreements with partner universities. For KTU students, study in partner universities is free of charge (except for summer schools). The travel and accommodation abroad



costs are to be covered by the student with the chance to

be awarded a KTU mobility scholarship.

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
